School Counseling at Beacon Cove Intermediate

A comprehensive system of school counseling supports are available to students.

Classroom Guidance

- Character Counts Traits, Conflict Resolution, Stress Relief Skills, Bullying, Students Success Skills

Small Group Counseling

- Grief, Changing Families (Divorce), Social Skills, Seeing Red (Anger), Confidence Builder, B.I.G (Behavior is Good) Referrals can be made by parents, teachers or students themselves. Parent permission required

Individual Counseling

- Students may receive brief counseling to promote social, emotional or behavioral growth within the school setting. Referrals can be made by parents, teachers or children themselves. Parent permission is required for multiple sessions and confidentiality is maintained

Who are School Counselors

Elementary school counselors deliver programs and interventions that promote student achievement, social/emotional development and college-career readiness. One of the most important roles of the school counselor is to help students to develop the essential mindset and behaviors for educational success (*American School Counselor Association*).

- **Mindset** – beliefs students have about themselves in relation to academic work
- **Behaviors** – learning strategies, self-management skills, and social skills

School counselors focus their unique knowledge and skills on providing school counseling core curriculum, individual counseling, small group counseling, and consultation to students, parents, teachers, and other stakeholders. They are certified educators with the minimum of a master's degree in school counseling and are uniquely qualified to address the developmental needs of all students through a comprehensive school counseling program.

School counseling services are available to all students throughout the school year. All students will participate in classroom guidance lessons. We also offer individual and small group counseling to assure that students with a specific needs can be addressed and taught the skills needed to be successful in the academic and personal areas.
